It is hard to imagine daily life without the convenience of frozen foods. Whenever we feel hungry, we can go to the freezer and take out something tasty to eat. It was an American inventor, Clarence Birdseye, who invented the process that lets us enjoy frozen foods so easily.

Birdseye began to study science at college but quit in 1910, when he got a job with the U.S. government. Later he went to the Arctic, where he was able to study the lifestyle of the local Inuit people. He noticed that they froze the fish they wanted to keep. The combination of ice, wind, and very cold temperatures had the effect of freezing the fish very quickly. Birdseye also noticed that the food tasted fresh even when it was cooked many months later.

Birdseye guessed that the secret of this fresh taste was the fact that the food had been frozen quickly. Back in the United States in 1923, he invented a system for quickly freezing fresh food under high pressure. A company bought his invention and in 1930 started selling frozen vegetables, fruit, fish, and meat to the public using the name Birds Eye Frosted Foods.

Birdseye then created open freezers that could be used to display frozen food in supermarkets. He also helped to develop refrigerated containers for transporting frozen foods by train. By 1944, Birds Eye frozen foods could be found all over the United States, and Birdseye himself was famous. Now, more than half a century has passed, but frozen foods are still produced using technology based on Birdseye's original idea.
